## 1. MOTION TO ADOPT AGENDA

President Darby called for a motion to adopt the agenda. A motion was presented by Mr. Sorrell and seconded by Mr. Phung. A vote was taken and the motion to adopt the agenda passed with aye votes from Mr. Sorrell, Mr. Sanders, Dr. Denson, and Mr. Phung.

## 2. PRESENTATIONS:

- Phillip Rogers with Encompass Health Lakeshore Rehab Hospital gave a presentation requesting after-hours verification by PipelineRx. After a discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Denson and seconded by Mr. Sorrell to approve the after-hours verification by PipelineRx. A vote was taken and the motion to approve after-hours verification by PipelineRx passed with aye votes from Mr. Sorrell, Mr. Sanders, Dr. Denson, and Mr. Phung.
- Austin Crowe with DeKalb Regional Hospital gave a presentation requesting the addition of PipelineRx's new Las Vegas, Nevada, and Denver, Colorado, facilities to perform after-hours verification for DeKalb Regional Hospital. A motion was made by Mr. Sorrell and seconded by Mr. Darby to approve the addition of PipelineRx's new Las Vegas, Nevada, and Denver, Colorado, facilities for after-hours verification. A vote was taken and the motion passed with aye votes from Mr. Sanders, Mr. Darby, Dr. Denson, and Mr. Phung.
- Kyle Sexton with L. V. Stabler Memorial Hospital gave a presentation requesting the addition of PipelineRx's new Las Vegas, Nevada, and Denver, Colorado, facilities to perform after-hours verification for L. V. Stabler Memorial Hospital. A motion was made by Mr. Sanders and seconded by Dr. Denson to approve the addition of PipelineRx's new Las Vegas, Nevada, and Denver, Colorado, facilities for after-hours verification. A vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.
- Chad Madill with Publix Supermarkets gave a presentation requesting approval of workload balancing between pods. He initially presented the request in October 2018 and the Board suggested Publix make changes to its model. The Board requested the verification pharmacist's initials be put on each vial of dispensed medications. It will take approximately 18 months for the IT team to change its system to provide that information, so Mr. Madill suggested placing customer-facing signage stating which local pharmacies are in the pod where pharmacist assistance could occur. Publix is also amending its model so that the local data entry technician is always at the same store as the final verification pharmacist.

A motion was made by Mr. Sanders and seconded by Dr. Denson to approve the workload balancing request with the requirement that Publix provide an updated written policy stating only a pharmacist in another store will do the preverification. A vote was taken and the motion passed unanimously.

- Steve Brindley with Rocket City Vital Care gave a presentation requesting reduced hours of operation until the pharmacy is open. Since the pharmacy is not open yet, there is no requirement for open hours, so no action was taken.
