1. MOTION TO ADOPT AGENDA

President Sanders called for a motion to adopt the agenda. A motion was presented by Mr. Colburn and seconded by Dr. Denson. A vote was taken and the motion to adopt the agenda passed unanimously.

2. PRESENTATIONS:

- Charles Cook with Marshall Medical Center presented the request for the ability as central fill to be able to fill our prescriptions at the Professional Pharmacy and then courier them to the north and south institutional pharmacies for our employees and our patients to be able to pick up. The Board tabled this for now until further research can be done.
- Brittany Lee gave a presentation on behalf of Atmore Community Hospital to request approval for a change in their remote order of verification provider from Infirmary Health out of Mobile to CPS Telepharmacy. A motion was made by Dr. Denson to approve the request to change remote order entry to CPS Telepharmacy for Atmore Community Hospital for the hours that were presented today. Mr. Phung seconded . A vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.
- Neil Hitchcock with Jack's Discount Pharmacy is asking for approval for technician Jessica Milam to be a Non-pharmacist key holder for the pharmacy. A motion was made by Dr. Denson to approve the non-pharmacist key holder request by Jack's Discount Pharmacy. Mr. Sorrell seconded. A vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.
- Tomie Ann Boackle on behalf of UAB Hospital presenting a request to have remote order entry between all 4 of the UAB institutional permits. UAB Highlands, UAB Medicine Free Standing Emergency Dept, and UAB infusion Pharmacy. Mr. Sorrell made a motion to approve the request for remote order entry between the four UAB facilities presented. Mr. Colburn seconded. A vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously.

3. TREASURER'S REPORT:

Treasurer Brenda Denson presented the treasurer's report. Total revenues are at 96.05 percent of the fiscal year budget. Total expenses are at 63.64 percent of the fiscal year budget, which is right on target for the year. A motion was made by Mr. Colburn and seconded by Mr. Phung to approve the treasurer's report. A vote was taken and the motion to approve the treasurer's report passed with aye votes from Mr. Sanders, Dr. Denson, and Mr. Sorrell.
